

DATA PRIVACY NOTICE

Stichting DAG MET EEN LACH

1. Your personal data – what is it?

Personal data relates to a living individual who can be identified from that data. Identification can be by the information alone or in conjunction with any other information in the data controller's possession or likely to come into such possession. The processing of personal data is governed by the General Data Protection Regulation (the "GDPR").

2. Who are we?

Stichting DAG MET EEN LACH ("DMEL") is the data controller (contact details below). This means it decides how your personal data is processed and for what purposes.

3. How do we process your personal data?

DMEL complies with its obligations under the "GDPR" by keeping personal data up to date; by storing and destroying it securely; by not collecting or retaining excessive amounts of data; by protecting personal data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access and disclosure and by ensuring that appropriate technical measures are in place to protect personal data.

We use your personal data for the following purposes: -

- To administer membership records;
- To manage our public events;
- To maintain our own accounts and records;
- To inform you of news, events, activities and services running at DMEL;

4. What is the legal basis for processing your personal data?

- Explicit consent of the data subject so that we can keep you informed about news, events, activities and services and keep you informed about events.
- Processing is necessary for carrying out events for which a person has explicitly registered.

5. Sharing your personal data

Your personal data will be treated as strictly confidential and will only be shared with other suppliers in order to carry out our services or for purposes connected with our services. We will only share your data with third parties outside of these purposes with your consent.

6. How long do we keep your personal data?

We keep data in accordance with the guidance set out in General Data Protection Regulations. We comply with the restricted period of storage of 2 years after the last contact or a longer period when legally needed.

7. Your rights and your personal data

Unless subject to an exemption under the GDPR, you have the following rights with respect to your personal data:

- The right to request a copy of your personal data which DMEL holds about you;
- The right to request that DMEL corrects any personal data if it is found to be inaccurate or out of date;
- The right to request your personal data is erased where it is no longer necessary for DMEL to retain such data;
- The right to withdraw your consent to the processing at any time
- The right to request that the data controller provide the data subject with his/her personal data and where possible, to transmit that data directly to another data controller, (known as the right to data portability), (where applicable) [*Only applies where the processing is based on consent or is necessary for the performance of a contract with the data subject and in either case the data controller processes the data by automated means*].
- The right, where there is a dispute in relation to the accuracy or processing of your personal data, to request a restriction is placed on further processing;
- The right to object to the processing of personal data, (where applicable) [*Only applies where processing is based on legitimate interests (or the performance of a task in the public interest/exercise of official authority)*]
- The right to lodge a complaint with the administrator of DMEL.

8. Further processing

If we wish to use your personal data for a new purpose, not covered by this Data Protection Notice, then we will provide you with a new notice explaining this new use prior to commencing the processing and setting out the relevant purposes and processing conditions. Where and whenever necessary, we will seek your prior consent to the new processing.
